Resolution No. 19/2000

ACCOUNTABILITY OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS

The 69th Conference of the International Law Association, held in London, United Kingdom, 25-29 July 2000:

HAVING CONSIDERED the Second Report of the Committee on Accountability of International Organisations;

AFFIRMS the need to consider what measures (legal, administrative or otherwise) should be adopted to ensure the accountability of public international organisations to their members and to third parties, and of members and third parties to such organisations;

NOTES the importance of the availability of information about practice for the progress of the work of the Committee;

INVITES all relevant international organisations and parties to assist the Committee in its work wherever possible;

INVITES the Committee to continue its work, taking into account the comments made at the London Conference and calls on the Committee to report thereon at the 70th Conference of the Association to be held in New Delhi in 2002.
